The more serious the event, the more platforms that will be utilized. While technology is widely used to support emergency communications, in the event that cell phones and/or landline telephones are not functional then emergency information will be shared on KOGO 600AM and through local community hubs.



Download the Poway City App. During an emergency event this free app will play a critical role in communicating with Poway residents by providing direct links to the latest city updates and key emergency resources.



Register for AlertSanDiego, the San Diego County's reverse 911 system. This registration associates your cell phone with your address for emergency alerts. All landlines are automatically added to the database.



Download the Genasys Protect App. Genasys Protect will provide residents with accurate evacuation mapping, road closures, and emergency shelter sites during a disaster.



Download the SD Emergency App to get valuable information before, during, and after an emergency. SD Emergency now includes ShakeReadySD, an earthquake early warning system.

If class, camp, or program is less than the \$19 cancellation fee, the refund will automatically be given as credit on account. Credit on account will be valid for one year and may be applied to another enrollment or reservation. If the credit is not used after one year, the funds will be forfeited and the customer's account will be cleared.

Except as otherwise provided in this policy, if a registrant fails to attend a program after it begins, the registrant is **not**

entitled to a refund. Exceptions may be authorized by the Director of Community Services. A doctor's note or written request describing the extenuating circumstances must be submitted to the Community Services Department within two weeks of the refund request.

Residency

Poway Residents are defined as those persons who live within the City limits of Poway. Proof of residency is required at the time of registration.

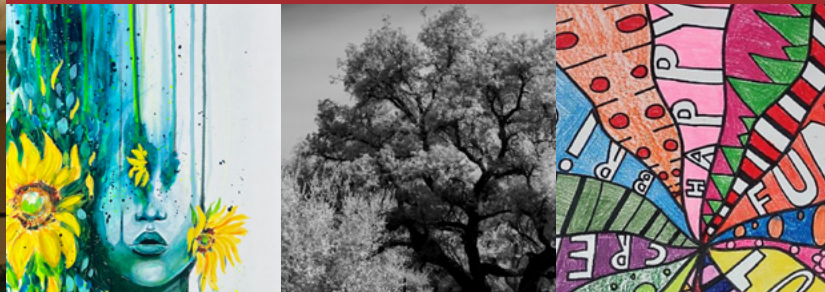

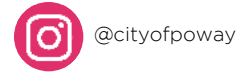
